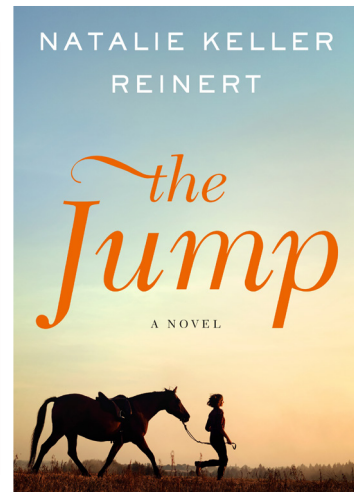

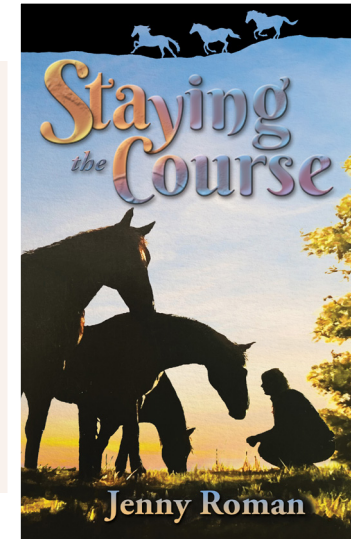
THE JUMP

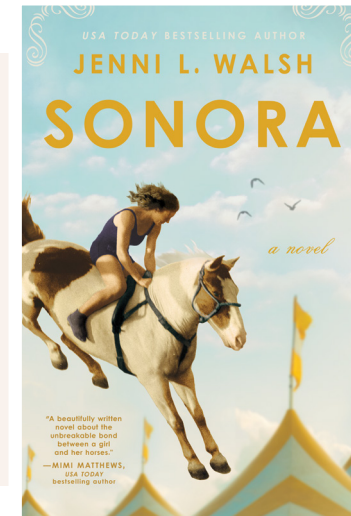
STARTING IN THE MIDDLE
